Health Insurance	<i>All students must own health insurance that covers the period during their stay in France. ESTP does not offer health insurance.</i> ○ All students must register to the French social security here ○ Europeans must have their European health insurance card.
CVEC Student and Campus Life Contribution	CVEC is a national fee paid by students every academic year. This contribution is "designed to promote social, health, cultural and sports support and assistance for students and to reinforce health prevention and education actions aimed at students" (<i>Article L. 841-5 of the French Education Code</i>). ○ Academic Exchange Students from partner universities are exempted from CVEC. ○ All degree-seeking Students (Double Degree included) must pay CVEC here.
