Study Courses	All ENTPE courses are open to exchange students. Mixing majors will be limited in order to avoid scheduling conflicts.
Course Catalogue & Course Language	Most courses are taught in French.
	ENTPE also offers 2 pathways taught through English as a medium of instruction. Those pathways are designed for Master/Post graduate
	students only (i.e. Master 1 and Master 2 students). The course catalogue taught through English is offered in Autumn semester.

Bologna Equivalence	ENTPE provides a 3-year full-time program. Its students are selected through a nationwide competitive entrance examination after having successfully completed a two-year undergraduate preparatory course.
	Year 1 at ENTPE = last year of Bachelor degree
	Year 2 at ENTPE = 1^{st} Year of Master degree Year 3 at ENTPE = 2^{nd} Year of Master degree
Language Requirements	Students applying for a French taught study course can apply with French proficiency of at least B1/B2 level of the CEFR.
	Students applying for an English taught course can apply with an English proficiency of at least B2 level of the CEFR (C1 advised).
	Exchange programs: Certificates issued by your university are allowed.
	Double-Degrees: Language Certificates have to be issued by certified language institutes.
French Courses	French as a foreign language elective is available on demand. The number of attributed ECTS varies depending on length and intensity
	of courses and needs of home university.
	ENTPE strongly advises incoming Erasmus students to take French courses during the mobility.
