This contribution is "designed to promote social, health, cultural and sports support and assistance for students and to reinforce health prevention and education actions aimed at students" (<i>Article L. 841-5 of the French Education Code</i>).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Academic Exchange Students from partner universities are exempted from CVEC.➤ All degree-seeking Students (Double Degree included) have to pay for CVEC here.
