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## COURSE & LANGUAGE DETAILS

Study Courses	All ENTPE courses are open to exchange students. Mixing majors will be limited in order to avoid scheduling conflicts.
Course Catalogue & Course Language	<p>Most courses are taught in French.</p> <p>ENTPE also offers 2 pathways taught through English as a medium of instruction. Those pathways are designed for Master/Post graduate students only (i.e. Master 1 and Master 2 students). The course catalogue taught through English is offered in Autumn semester.</p> <p>English courses are open subject to the number of participants.</p> <p><u>Catalogues :</u> <a href="#">ENTPE Course catalogue</a> (French taught) ENTPE Course catalogue taught through English (upon request)</p>
Bologna Equivalence	<p>ENTPE provides a 3-year full-time program.</p> <p>Its students are selected through a nationwide competitive entrance examination after having successfully completed a two-year undergraduate preparatory course.</p> <p>Year 1 at ENTPE = last year of Bachelor degree Year 2 at ENTPE = 1<sup>st</sup> Year of Master degree Year 3 at ENTPE = 2<sup>nd</sup> Year of Master degree</p>
Language Requirements	<p>Students applying for a French taught study course can apply with French proficiency of at least B1/B2 level of the CEFR.</p> <p>Students applying for an English taught course can apply with an English proficiency of at least B2 level of the CEFR (C1 advised).</p> <p><u>Exchange programs:</u> Certificates issued by your university are allowed.</p> <p><u>Double-Degrees:</u> Language Certificates have to be issued by certified language institutes.</p>
French Courses	<p>French as a foreign language elective is available on demand.</p> <p>The number of attributed ECTS varies depending on length and intensity of courses and needs of home university.</p> <p>ENTPE strongly advises incoming Erasmus students to take French courses during the mobility.</p> <p>French as a foreign language courses will be mandatory for ENTPE degree-seeking international students if their level of French is deemed insufficient for academic success and/or successful integration in France.</p>

## HOUSING

Housing	<p>Incoming Erasmus+ students can benefit from ENTPE's partnership with local municipal landlords providing affordable housing close to ENTPE Campus.</p> <p>Incoming Erasmus+ students may also be in contact with ENTPE students looking for/living in shared accommodation.</p>
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
